How did Ideas for Dublin begin?

Two people had a conversation about harnessing the spirit of creativity in Ireland. That idea took shape and developed into Ideas for Dublin. They shared their idea with many people, including the Lord Mayor, Councillor Eibhlin Byrne. Everyone thought that it was a good idea so they decided to go for it and Ideas for Dublin was born!

Submit –

You will be able to submit your ideas by...

2. Jotting them down on a sheet of paper – with the help of our team

Develop and Grow –

Our hope is that everyone will share and submit an idea, that the critical mass of ideas will be discussed and grow, and that the ideas will connect and produce a vibrant community of creative thinkers that can collectively tackle our challenges.

Celebrate –

To help connect the ideas that have been submitted, the Lord Mayor, Councillor Eibhlin Byrne will host a celebration. Every person who has submitted an idea will be invited to join, display their idea and connect with similar intended ideas.
